Instructions - Most Urgent

It is unfortunate to find that inspite of the various directives issued to the CHSS beneficiaries of RRCAT, large number of people are visiting RMC everyday in direct violation of the Office Order no. 14/05/2020-GAC/676 dated March 31, 2020. This is in gross defiance of the intent of country's fight against wide spread of COVID-19 virus. It must be appreciated by all that the only way to fight the spread of COVID-19 is to confine ourselves to our houses thereby necessitating country wide lockdown with imposition of IPC sec 144; therefore each and everyone must not step out of their houses till further orders. Such movements outside their house not only make the very individual vulnerable to COVID-19 infection and on the other hand it will create

threat to health and functioning of essential staff of RMC and others.

In view of the present rapidly increasing COVID-19 cases in and around Indore city, the CHSS beneficiaries are once again requested to strictly adhere to the instructions contained in the above mentioned Office Order, failing which an appropriate disciplinary action will be taken against the employees who directly visit dispensary for insignificant and minor complaints. This may include temporary suspension of the CHSS membership with immediate effect on account of violating the said Office Order. It is further emphasized that the Entry to RMC will be given to only those who have been advised by RMC doctor-onduty to visit dispensary for 'in person consultation ' based on their telephonic consultation in priory to visiting the RMC. All CHSS beneficiaries are earnestly requested to strictly adhere to the instructions

However suspected cases of COVID-19, if any will be referred to the designated hospitals as per the advise of RMC doctors following the laid out procedure by IMC time to time.
